How much is the WEBELOS-ree?

\$15.00 per WEBELOS. The money goes towards the water bottle, facility fees, program fees, etc..

What days do the WEBELOS attend?

Friday, October 27th from 5:30 pm and Saturday, October 28th, all day. For those doing the Outdoorsman adventure, you may spend the night on Friday night, October 27th. If you are not doing the Outdoorsman adventure you may still camp Friday night. Everyone is welcomed to camp whether you're working on the Outdoorsman adventure or not.

Tell me about the camping

Those WEBELOS that are camping MUST have a parent with each WEBELOS. This is the rules of BSA. Bring your own camping gear. Refer to your handbooks for what to bring on a campout. Parents are responsible for their own WEBELOS. A campsite will be assigned when you check-in. Please check-in with HQ before setting up.

What about the Boy Scouts camping?

Troops will lead their chosen adventure in their campsite. Troops may set up Friday night and camp if they wish. Campsites will be assigned. Please check-in with HQ before setting up.

What about food?

Every individual is responsible for their own food. You may eat before arrival, cook with your den or patrol, or cook for yourself. NO open fires will be allowed in the camping areas; propane camp stoves are acceptable. Sack lunches, water bottles and snacks are a good idea for Saturday. Lunch from Bojangles is available by preorder at the time of registration and will be delivered to HQ on Saturday. The Bojangles lunch consists of 3 chicken strips, 1 biscuit, 1 side of mac & cheese, and costs \$3.25

What if our family wants to attend?

Family members may observe sessions but please be considerate of the participants and instructors. Parents and siblings many not take part in the sessions.

Can our family eat with us?

What do we bring to each session?

The Boy Scout Troop that is leading an adventure will provide all the materials necessary for the WEBELOS to work on requirements. Each WEBELOS will need to print a copy of the Adventure Record Sheet which can be found at http://www.atbsa.org/webelos-ree.html and carry it with them to each adventure and have it signed to record what requirements he has completed.

Who is paying for supplies for these sessions?

The Troops are responsible for the material necessary to conduct their session. We are all considering this an investment in the future of our Troops and it is a great recruiting opportunity as well as an opportunity for us to show off our Scout instructors.

Can we have a fire Friday night?

There is a scheduled campfire on Friday evening. Your Scout is encouraged to stick around after the campfire and enjoy. There are no other approved campfires.

What about parking?

Parking at the Church of the Messiah is limited. There is another group using the church Saturday. There will be staff directing parking. Please pack along your patience and good cheer.
